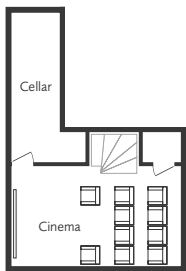

Lower ground level



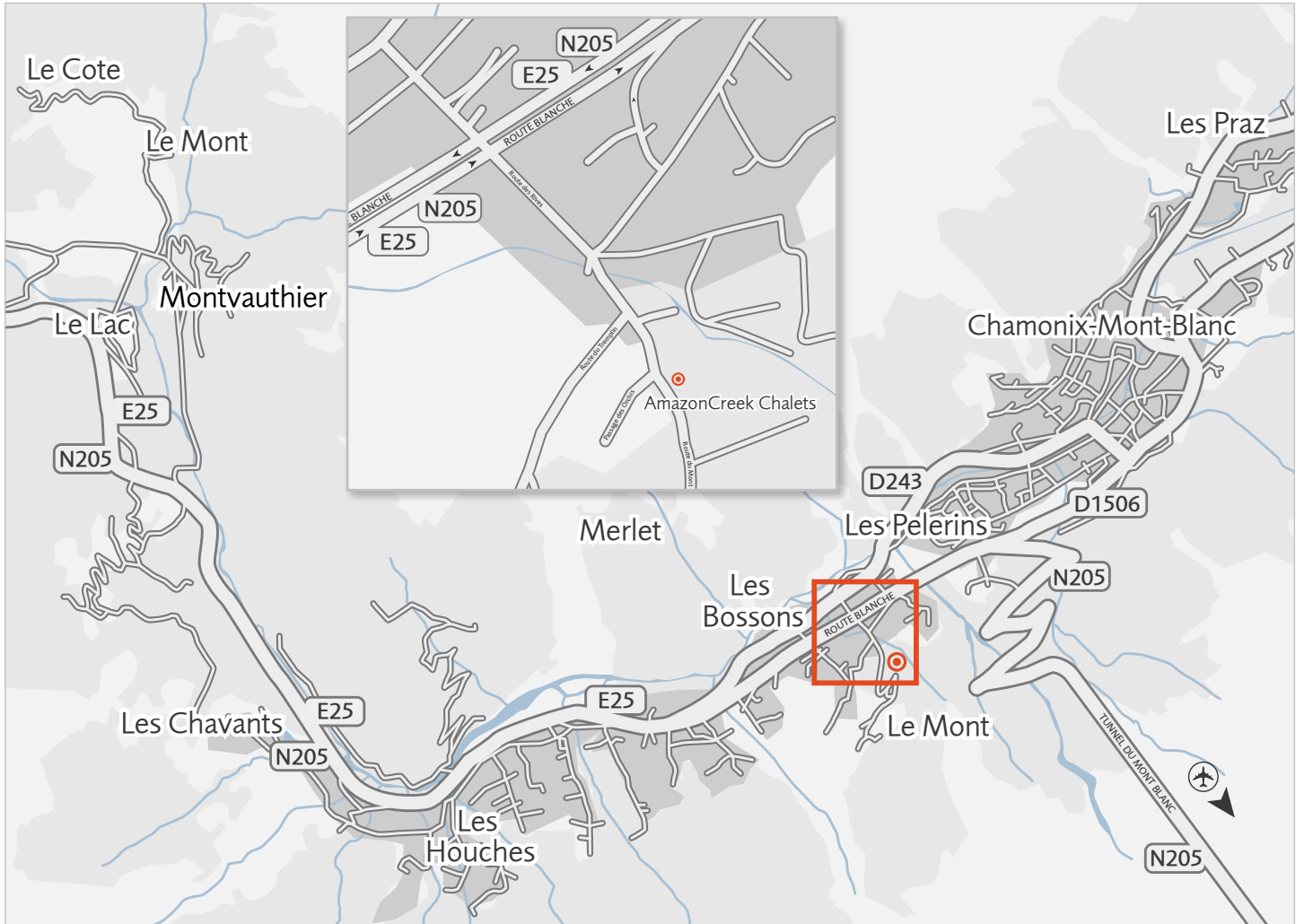
Ground level

### How to get there

From Geneva airport (Swiss side) follow signs to France (be aware that some of these are fairly small)

After approx 10km you will cross the Swiss/French border

After crossing the border stay in the **right hand lane** and follow the signs to **Chamonix Mt Blanc**

After approx 7km the road splits. Take the **left hand lane** and following the signs to **Chamonix Mt Blanc**. This road will now take you all of the way to the Chamonix valley (approx 80km)

Once you have driven up the viaduct into the Chamonix Valley you will travel past Les Houches St Antoine exit. Keep going, past Exit 27 Graviers

Go through a small tunnel

Keep going straight ahead for approximately 2km

You will see a sign for exit 30

Take Exit 30 on your right, named Les Bossons / Glacier des Bossons.

Turn right at the stop sign onto 'Route des Tissieres'

Keep driving straight up the hill

Turn left onto 'Route du Tremplin'

Go Straight on until you get to a T junction and another stop sign

Turn right and drive for approximately 400m

Your Chalet is on your left, number 165 on the green letter box

Continue up the drive, Chalet Baloo is the first chalet on your left.
